General Business

Minutes for 2024 read by Charles Vallance.

Accepted Jason Sandham Seconded John Arrowsmith

Charles Vallance spoke about the need to review the decision to admit state players into the Legends competition. Our playing numbers for the national competition has grown each year and there are many older state players interested in the weeklong event.

Colin Choules stated professional dart players should not be admitted. Charles advised that they would probably not be interested in our comp. Connie Spinks explained divisions would be adjusted as there is a 20% rule regarding divisions. Wendy Quinn felt we should only allow 1 state player per team to avoid stacked teams. Loz Ryder felt that premier players only should make decision, however all stated that every person was entitled to vote. The proposal was put to the floor that state players be allowed to attend provided they are in Premier Division for all events, no more that one state player per team or doubles event. Proposal was carried. Playing rules will be amended and posted on website in due course.

Shelly Spark (Vic) requested clarification regarding drinking at board while throwing or chalking. Charlie advised that player cannot carry drink to board or to chalk, however once throw completed then player may return to table to drink before their next throw.

Hosting state for next national event is Gosford NSW. It is proposed that opening ceremony will follow the AGM. At present \$20 is charged for opening ceremony by making the ceremony free without food being available will possibly attract more attendance. This situation will be trialled at Gosford.

Reminder again that AGM is alcohol free but the bar will be opened once AGM has concluded.

Charlie advised smoking areas will be front entrance near soccer field and back entrance next to goalies net. Food served in soccer hall, breakfast burgers available from 8.30 to 10.30. Please use yellow and red bins appropriately. No alcohol to be taken out of the hall.

Closing ceremony is taking place at Civic Centre in Punt Road.

Smoke and Alcohol Police (Alley Hawkins) will charge \$2,00 smoke violation or \$5 alcohol violation if you are caught. Charlie will advise at closing ceremony where the money will be donated.
